DIRECTIONS

FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

- This trial is held under the Sporting Code of the ACU and in accordance with the ACU Environmental Code.
- 2. Any supplementary instruction changes to sections and times will be amended on the day at the signing on area.
- 3. Section markings (Non Stop TSR22B):

ROUTE	MARKERS	
ROUTE 1	▶ ◀ Blue on the left, Red on the right	
ROUTE 50/50	Green markers	
ROUTE 2	Yellow markers	
ROUTE 3	White markers ■ White markers	

- 4. Starting order has been determined by pre-event ballot. Riders will start at 1 minute intervals.
- 5. Each section must be attempted in the order in which they are numbered.
- An assistant may be registered to accompany each rider. They must be a minimum of 18 years, have completed an entry form and sign on.
 Assistants must not ride machines.
- Any rider, or third party with an interest in a rider's performance, reported
 to the clerk of course for arguing or being offensive to an observer, or other
 official, renders that rider liable to disciplinary action.
- 8. Time limit is 5 hours and 30 minutes, riders must sign off at the end of the trial. Riders will be penalised one mark per minute up to a maximum of 20 for exceeding the stipulated time limit.
- Riders are to be responsible for their own punch card AT ALL TIMES and
 it must be the rider who presents it to the observer for punching at each
 section. All riders to change punch cards at Secretary's building at the end
 of each lap. (TSR19 Punch Cards).
- The start area is a silent zone.
 No starting of machines will be permitted until called to do so.
