Final instructions

- This trial is held under the Sporting Code of the ACU and in accordance with the ACU Environmental Code.
- 2. Any supplementary instruction changes to sections and times will be amended on the day at the signing on area.
- 3. Road route markers:

- 5. Each observed section must be attempted in the order in which they are numbered. Observers will be using section cards please remember to give the observer correct social distance.
- 6. Any rider, or third party with an interest in a rider's performance, reported to the clerk of course for arguing or being offensive to an observer, or other official, renders that rider liable to disciplinary action.
- 7. Time limit is 7 hours. You will be timed off at the last section of the day.
- 8. Riders must adhere to all speed limits. This is not a closed circuit, so speed must be kept slow on narrow lanes / green lanes.
- 9. The car park and start areas are SILENT zones. No starting of machines will be permitted until called to do so.
